NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the following Dragon Class Keel boat events will be taking place. There will be 24 Dragon Class Keel Boats taking part over a course to be decided on the day. The courses will be approximately 2nm long set windward/ leeward. For possible locations of the event, see attached chart.



The International Dragon Class SW Area Championships will take place as follows

- Sunday 3rd July Three Races Back to Back First Warning Signal 1055
- Monday 4th July Three Races Back to Back First Warning Signal 1055

The International Dragon Class Edinburgh Cup

- Tuesday 5th July Two Races back to back First Warning Signal 1125
- Wednesday 6th July Two Races back to back First Warning Signal 1125
- Thursday 7th July Two Races back to back First Warning Signal 1125
- Friday 8th July One Race First Warning Signal 1055

Races are expected to take around 90 to 120 minutes with a maximum of 180 minutes

Mariners are requested to navigate with particular caution during this period and are reminded of Falmouth Harbour Byelaw 13, which requires masters of small craft to avoid obstructing or impeding racing vessels. See link below:
