

## PORT NOTICE TO MARINERS

### **James Wharram Memorial – 22<sup>nd</sup>-25<sup>th</sup> 2022**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that** over the weekend of July 22<sup>nd</sup> - 25<sup>th</sup> 2022 there will be a memorial Parade of Sail in celebration of James Wharram who passed away on 14<sup>th</sup> December 2021. James was considered to be the pioneer of offshore multihulls, making his first Atlantic crossing by catamaran in 1956 and the first ever North Atlantic West-to-East crossing by multihull in 1959. He started designing for self-builders in 1965.



#### **Friday 22 July**

- 23'6" James Wharram "Mana" (Pictured above) to be moored along the southern quay of Customs House Quay. This is the same place where James, Ruth and Jutta were moored on "Tangaroa" in 1955.

#### **Saturday 23 July**

- A fleet of Wharram catamarans (circa 13) and other boats join "Mana" to scatter the ashes of James and Ruth on the outgoing tide.
- Depart Falmouth in a Parade of Sail at HW to scatter the ashes on the outgoing tide.
- Date and time of Parada of Sail, to be confirmed nearer the time, based on the weather forecast.

Mariners are requested to navigate with particular caution during this period

This notice will be self-cancelling on completion of parade of sail.
