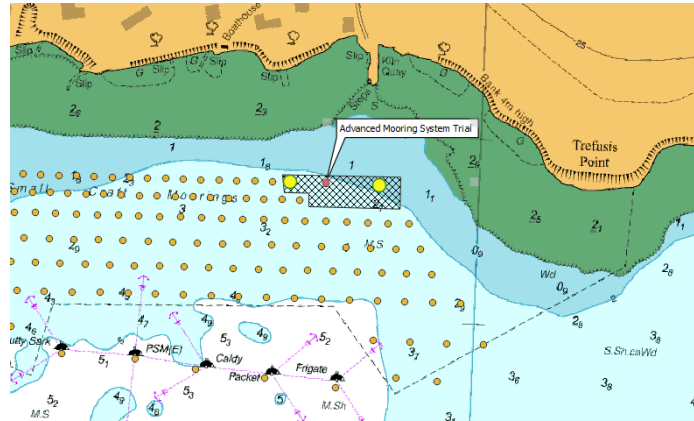


PORT NOTICE TO MARINERS

NO. 19 OF 2022

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Falmouth Harbour Commissioners have installed a further Advanced Mooring System off Flushing Beach in the following approximate location. – 50° 9.69' 5° 3.57'

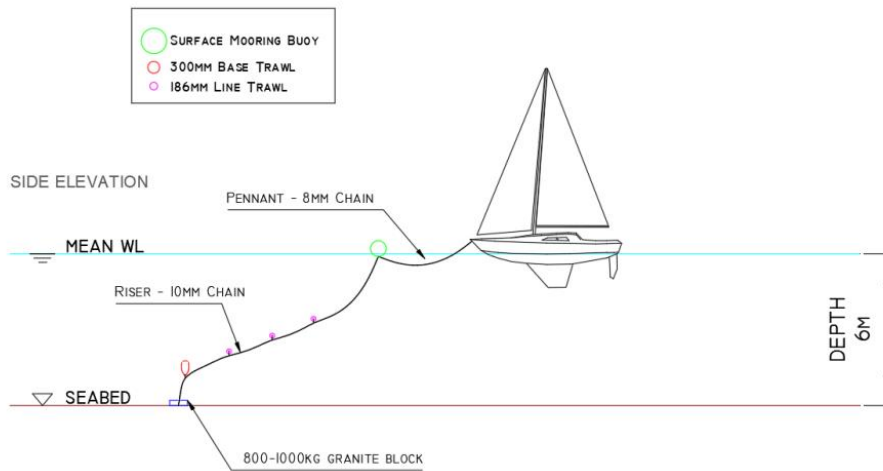


Fig 1 Mooring arrangement

This advanced mooring system will have a boat attached to it. Floats are used along the length of mooring chain to raise the chain off the seabed (see fig 1) chain may be closer to the surface than normally expected. Mariners should navigate with care in the area and allow 15m between themselves and the bow of the boat particularly at low tide.

This mooring will be in place for August and September this year.

Mariners are reminded of bylaw 14. regarding Navigating in mooring areas

- (1) The master of a vessel shall not navigate in the moorings areas except to such extent as may be necessary to navigate to or from a mooring or a landing place inside such areas.
- (2) The master of any vessel shall navigate it with care and caution and at slow speed in and near such areas.
