## PORT NOTICE TO MARINERS

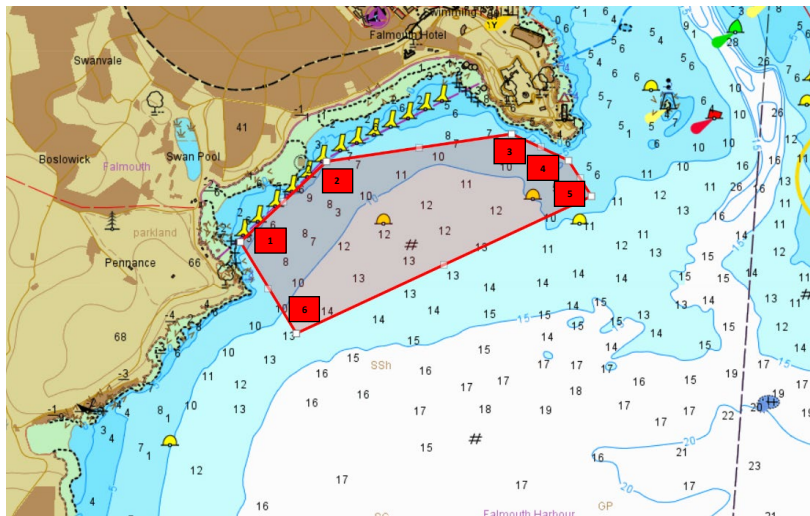

### Armed Forces Day – Air Display Exclusion Zone

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT** an exclusion zone will be in place in Falmouth Bay on 24-06-2023. This is to ensure safety for all, during a planned air display, which takes place between 1500-1730. The exclusion zone is defined as the shaded area on the below chart, which is the area inside the below co-ordinates.

No vessels shall enter or be within the exclusion zone between 1445-1730. Any vessels breaching this exclusion zone during these times will cause the air display to be cancelled. Vessels shall follow any directions from Falmouth Harbour Masters, staff or guard boats. This exclusion Zone will be established using Special directions under section 52 of the HDPCA 1847, as incorporated into the Falmouth Harbour Act 1958.

#### Additional notes:

1. It is expected that there will be a significant number of leisure and other vessels afloat on the day as well as programmed racing, including the Working Boat Championships. All vessels are required to navigate with extreme caution in the vicinity of the exclusion zone perimeter and are reminded of Falmouth Harbour Bye-Law 13, which requires masters of small craft to avoid obstructing or impeding racing vessels: Falmouth Harbour (General) Bye-Laws.
2. Note that vessels can be directed by special direction to vacate this exclusion zone, by any Harbour Master officer acting as Harbour Master at that time.
