



## **PORT NOTICE TO MARINERS**

**NO. 18 OF 2023**

### **FALMOUTH CLASSICS**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the 2023 Falmouth Classics is due to take place on the 16<sup>th</sup> – 18<sup>th</sup> June 2023. In excess of 100 boats are expected to take part across various classes.

Three races are planned for the event, together with a splendid parade of all participating boats followed by a small boat parade (vessels 20' and under). There will also be a rowing and sculling competition and a Classic Maritime Village.

- All races will start in The Carrick Roads
- Races will last approximately 2 hours
- The finish, for each race, is likely to be off Trefusis Point
- The courses chosen by the race officer will be dependent on wind direction and the tide
- Some courses may take vessels out into Falmouth Bay
- Race communications will be on VHF channel 77 as will the parade of sail

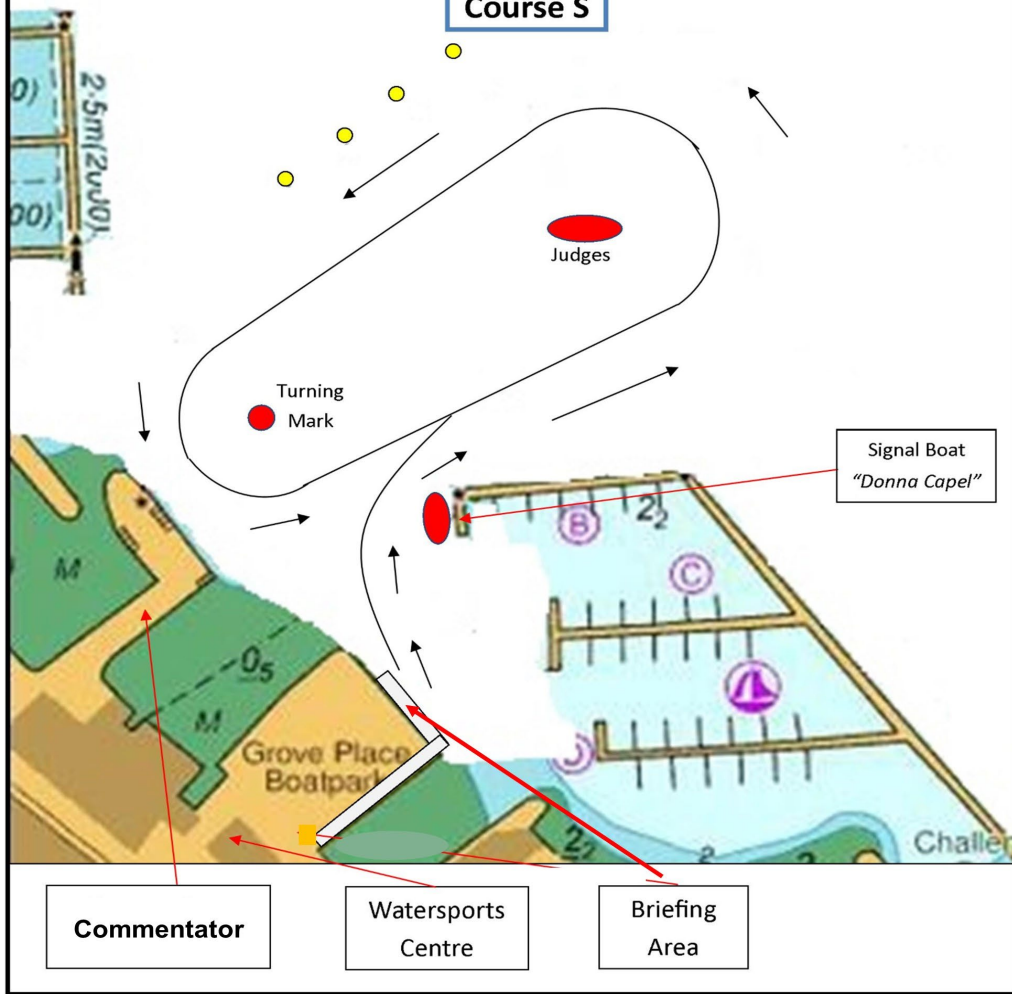

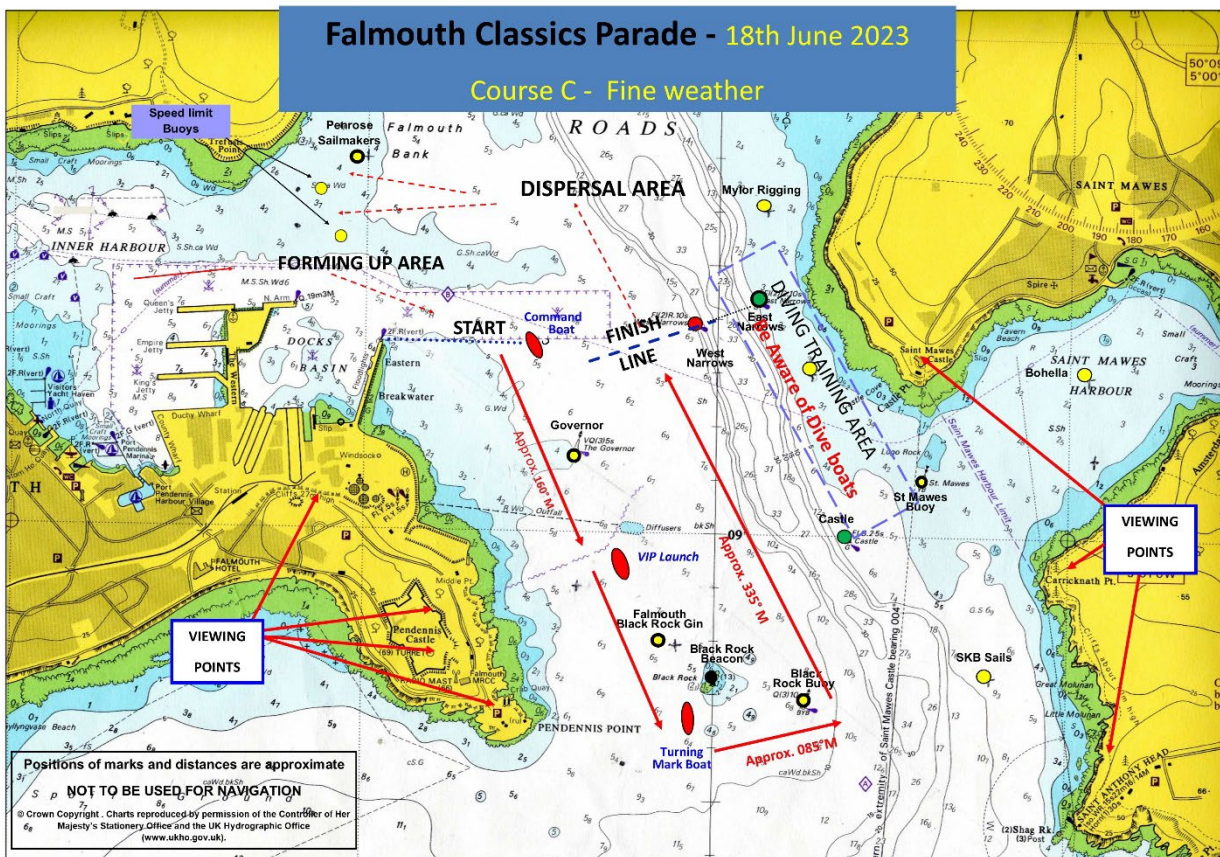

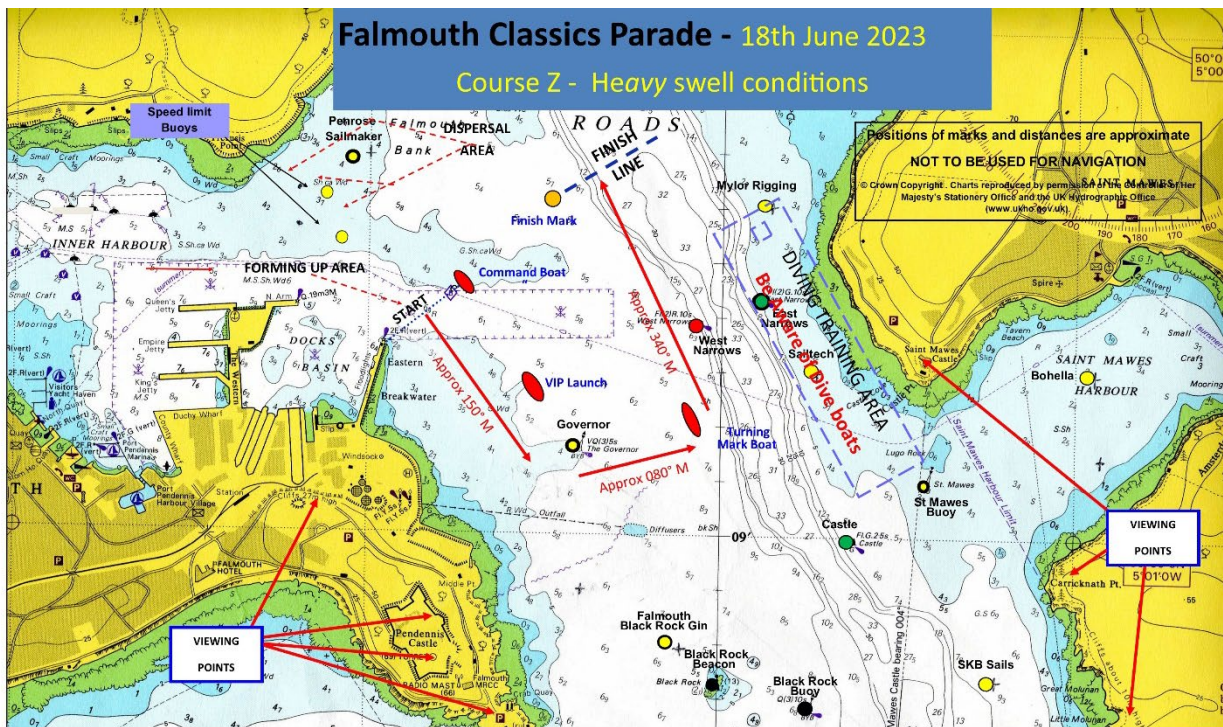
