## **Notice to Mariners No. 21 of 2023**

### **Ajax National Championships**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Ajax National Championships will be held in Falmouth Bay on the 28<sup>th</sup>, 29<sup>th</sup>, and 30<sup>th</sup> of July 2023. This event is being organised by the St Mawes Sailing Club and it will involve around 15 open 23 keelboats.

Courses will be Windward-Leeward or Windward-Leeward-Triangle as described in the sailing instructions. Races will be approximately 60 minutes in duration. A minimum of 4 races shall be completed to constitute the championship.

The race committee may make use of marine VHF channel 77 to make announcements to competitors, including during the pre-start period.

Mariners are requested to navigate with caution during this period and are reminded of Falmouth Harbour Byelaw 13 which requires masters of small craft to avoid obstructing or impeding racing vessels.

This notice is self-cancelling after the completion of the event.
