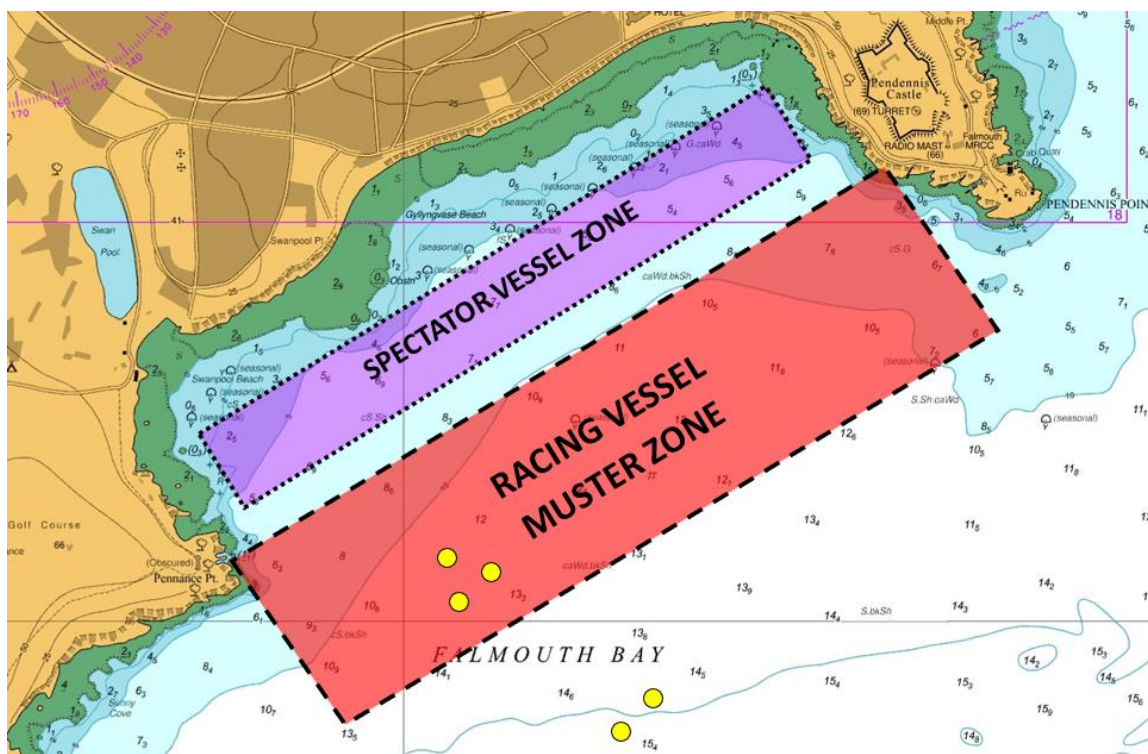

Notice to Mariners No. 20 of 2023

Cornish 100 Offshore Powerboat Race

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that an offshore Powerboat race and Thundercat racing event will be taking place in Falmouth Bay at 12:30 on Saturday 29th July, subject to weather conditions. The race will be run by World Power Boat Events, sanctioned by UKOPRA and there will be around 20 to 30 vessels participating. Prior to the, there will be a parade of vessels around Pendennis Point across to Pennance Point leaving Pendennis Marina at 12:00.

All non-participating vessels are requested to remain well clear of the racing vessel muster zone and, if spectating, within the designated spectator vessel zone as indicated in the chartlet below. Mariners are also advised that six yellow inflatable buoys will be established immediately prior to the start of the race, in the approximate positions indicated in the chartlet below.
