FALMOUTH SAILING WEEK 2023

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Sailing Races will be held in Falmouth Bay and in Carrick Roads from, Sunday 6th August 2023 to Saturday 12th August 2023, inclusive.

Approximately 50 yachts will be racing in the Bay and approximately 100 dayboats and dinghies in the Roads. There will be multiple races and classes on each day:

- For the Carrick Roads the first race is scheduled to start at 1205 on each day except Wednesday when it is 1105.
- For the Bay the first race of the day will not be before 1100 on each day except Wednesday when it will not be before 1030.

Racing will continue until late afternoon.

The courses will be set on the day according to the prevailing conditions.

Mariners are requested to navigate with particular caution during this period and are reminded of Falmouth Harbour Bye-Law 13, which requires masters of small craft to avoid obstructing or impeding racing vessels: [Falmouth Harbour \(General\) Bye-Laws](#)

Commercial craft, warships and auxiliaries are requested to call Falmouth Pilots on VHF CH 09 before entering port limits to determine large vessel movements in relation to regatta courses set on the day.
