Notice to Mariners No. 33 of 2023 (Amendment)

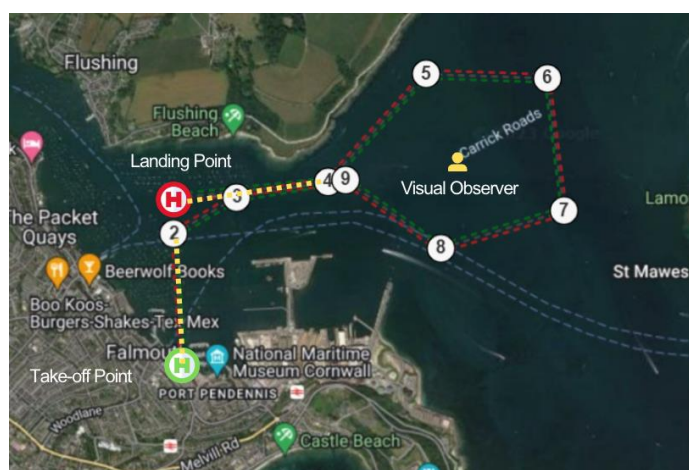
Open Skies “ship to shore” drone test flight – Falmouth Harbour

This amendment replaces the previously issued Notice 33 dated 14/12/2023.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Open Skies are planning to undertake a drone test flight in Falmouth Harbour. The test is scheduled to take place on Monday 18th and Tuesday the 19th of December at around 11:00 both days.

The Drone will be supplied by Skyports who will manage all flight operations. This will be the first trial of such a kind with a commercial drone in the UK and is part of Open Skies Project.

Below is a map showing the planned flight path taking off from the position marked with a green “H” (which will be Custom House Quay) and landing zone which will be a moored pontoon at the position marked with a red “H”. Pedestrians are asked to keep clear of Custom House Quay past the cordoned off area. Harbour vessels will be in attendance and all vessels are requested to keep clear and follow any instruction from harbour staff.



This notice is self-cancelling upon completion or the cancellation of the trial.
