



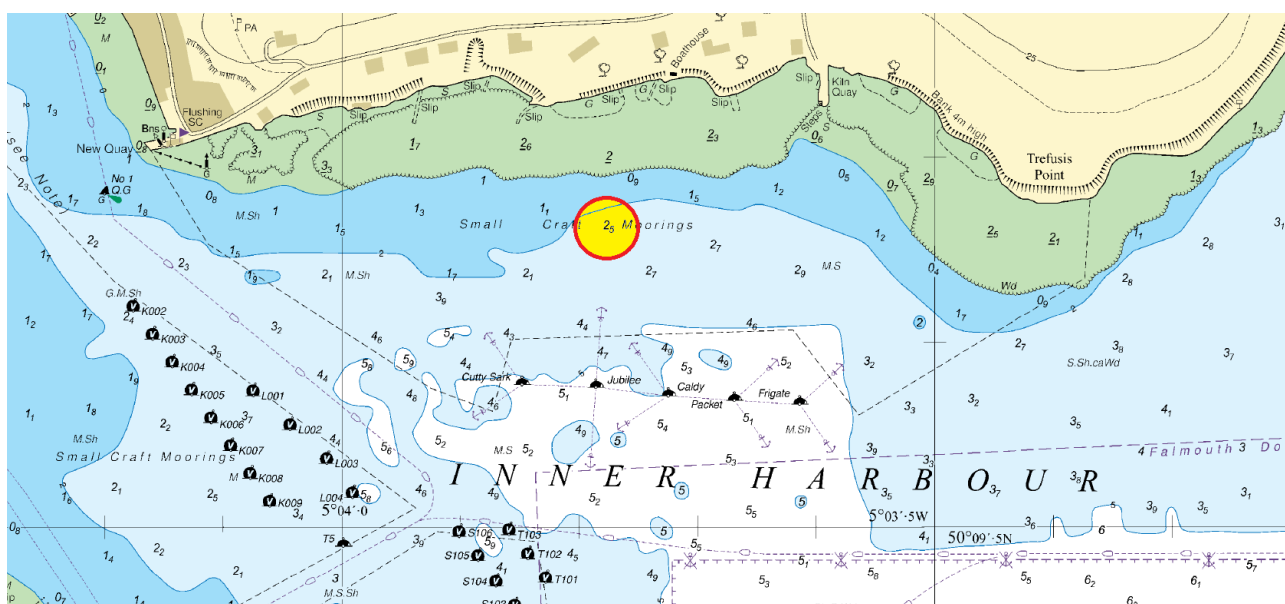

## Notice to Mariners No. 6 of 2024

# Sunken Vessel on Flushing Moorings

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that a yacht has sunk on Flushing Mooring B225. The yacht's mast is visible at Low Water and a fluorescent marking has been attached, but the mast may be fully submerged at High Water. All vessels are to navigate with extreme caution in the vicinity of Mooring B225. The approximate area is indicated by the yellow circle in the chartlet below.

Vessel Masters are reminded of Harbour General Byelaw 14<sup>1</sup> prohibiting navigation in mooring areas except to such extent as may be necessary to navigate to or from a mooring and of the requirement to navigate with care, caution and at slow speed in mooring areas.
