# Notice to Mariners No. 9 of 2024 Paddle Out Protest

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that a paddle out protest is planned to take place from Gyllyngvase Beach on Saturday 18<sup>th</sup> May 2024. The protest is subject to the weather conditions and a safety assessment on the day.

The event will commence at 11:00 and will involve up to 500 people using a variety of small paddle craft. The event will be marshaled, and participants are requested to remain North of the yellow 4 knot speed marker buoys during the protest, as indicated in the chartlet below:

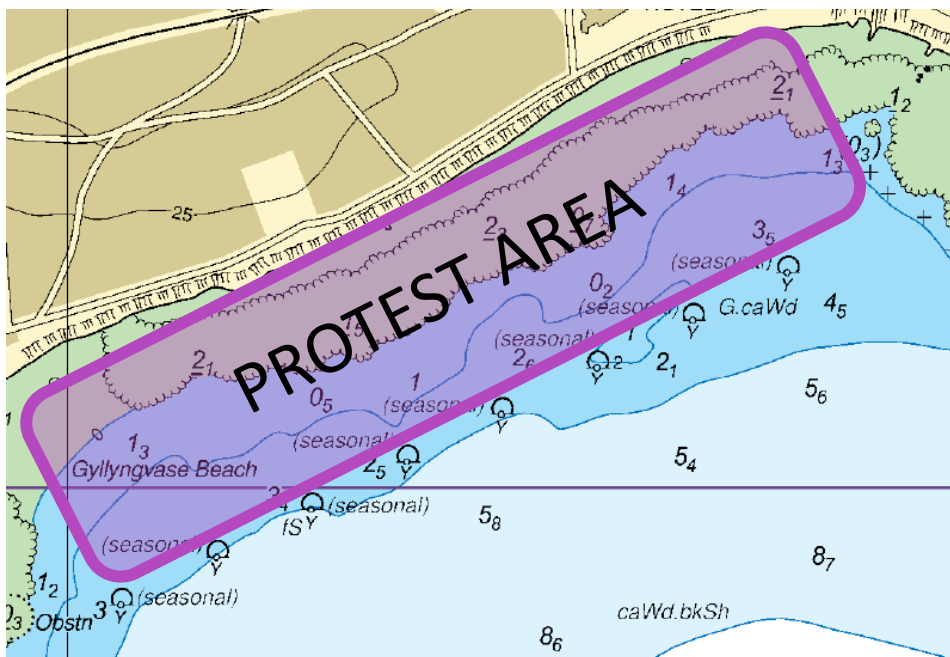


Figure 1 © Crown Copyright and/or database rights. Reproduced by permission of The Keeper of Public Records and the UK Hydrographic Office ([www.GOV.uk/UKHO](http://www.GOV.uk/UKHO)) NOT TO BE USED FOR NAVIGATION
