Notice to Mariners No. 10 of 2024

Upton Slip – Underwater Obstructions

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on or about 10th May 2024 a series of reef cubes and granite blocks will be laid on the foreshore alongside the sea wall tiles on the South Eastern wall of Church Street Car Park in the area known as Upton Slip, as indicated by the red area in the chartlet below:

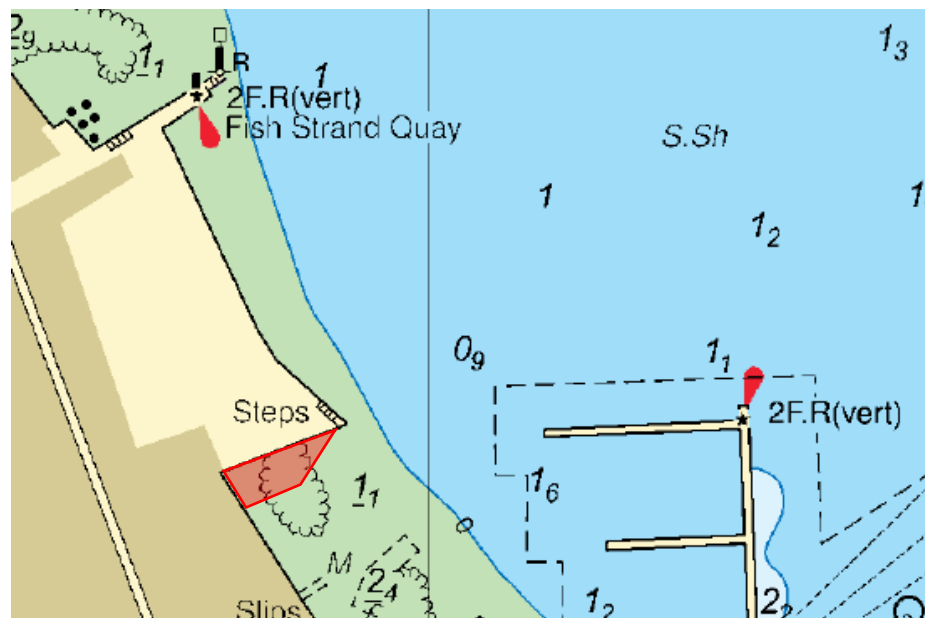


Figure 1 © Crown Copyright and/or database rights. Reproduced by permission of The Keeper of Public Records and the UK Hydrographic Office (www.gov.uk/UKHO) NOT TO BE USED FOR NAVIGATION

The outer extremity of the cubes will be indicated by the relocation of the three existing yellow special marks, and warning signage will be affixed to the car park railings. **Vessels must not berth alongside the car park wall or dry in this area due to the underwater obstructions.**

The installation date may be affected by weather and operational requirements.
