Notice to Mariners No. 13 of 2024 Large Vessel Mooring Lines

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that two classic sailing yachts will be occupying the large vessel moorings in the Inner Harbour. Vessels are advised to navigate with caution as mooring lines extend up to 20m forward and aft to the mooring buoys. These mooring buoys and lines are unlit. The yachts are expected to occupy these moorings until the 6th June 2024.
