Sigma 33 Offshore Championship 2024 and Ballad UK Class National Championship 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Sigma 33 Offshore One-Design Class Championship 2024 will take place from Wednesday 19th to Sunday 23rd June 2024 alongside the Ballad UK Class National Championship 2024 which will run from Friday 21st to Monday 24th June 2024.

The organising authority for both events is the Royal Cornwall Yacht Club (RCYC). Racing will take place in Falmouth Bay or adjacent waters to the east. If conditions in the Bay are unsuitable, racing may be held within the Carrick Roads.

There may be up to 25 yachts racing across the two classes. On the water, the race committee intends to monitor and communicate with competitors on VHF channel 77.

Non-participating vessels are requested to navigate with caution during this period and are reminded of Falmouth Harbour Byelaw 13 which requires masters of small craft to avoid obstructing or impeding racing vessels.

This notice is self-cancelling after the completion of the events.
