Falmouth Notice to Mariners No. 21 of 2024 & Truro Harbour Notice No. 7 of 2024 Moth National Championships

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that between 11th and 14th July 2024 the International Moth UK National Championships will be taking place in the Carrick Roads and Falmouth Bay, hosted by Restronguet Sailing Club.

The event will consist of up to 50 hydrofoiling Moth dinghies racing, accompanied by a fleet of safety boats. Up to Sixteen Races will take place in the Carrick Roads or Falmouth Bay (depending upon the conditions), spread across the four days of the event.

The race committee and support vessels will be operating on VHF channel M2.

Moth dinghies are hydrofoiling vessels that can travel at high speeds. Nonparticipating vessels are requested to keep at least 100 metres away from any participants and navigate with particular caution during this period.

All Vessels are reminded of Byelaw 13 of the [Truro Harbour \(General\) Byelaws 1992](#) and Byelaw 13 of the [Falmouth Harbour \(Amendment\) Bye-laws 1996](#) regarding obstruction or interference with organised events.
