



Notice to Mariners

NO. 23 of 2024

Air Display Exclusion Zone

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT an exclusion zone will be in place in Falmouth Bay on 14th August 2024. This is to ensure safety for all, during a planned air display, which takes place between 18:00 and 19:15. The exclusion zone is defined as the shaded area on the below chart. The inner area previously used for small craft has been designated for paddle craft and is a no anchoring zone.

No vessels shall enter or be within the exclusion zone between 17:45 and 19:15. All vessels to stay SOUTH of the exclusion zone. Any vessel breaching this exclusion zone during these times will cause the air display to be cancelled. Vessels shall follow any directions from Falmouth Harbour Masters, staff or guard boats. Official vessels will be flying a blue "Falmouth Harbour" flag.
