# Notice to Mariners No. 12 of 2025

## Falmouth Classics

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the 2025 Falmouth Classics is due to take place from the 13<sup>th</sup> to the 15<sup>th</sup> of June 2025. In excess of 100 vessels are expected to take part across various classes.

Three races are planned for the event (two on Friday and one on Saturday), together with a parade of all participating boats (on Sunday) followed by a small boat parade (vessels 20' and under). There will also be a rowing and sculling competition.

- Racing will take place in Carrick Roads and Falmouth Bay on "round the cans" courses.
- Races will last approximately 2 hours
- The finish for each race is likely to be off Trefusis Point
- The courses chosen by the race officer will be dependent on wind direction and the tide
- Some courses may take vessels out into Falmouth Bay
- Race communications will be on VHF channel 77, as will the parade of sail
- Details of the Parade of Sail are provided overleaf

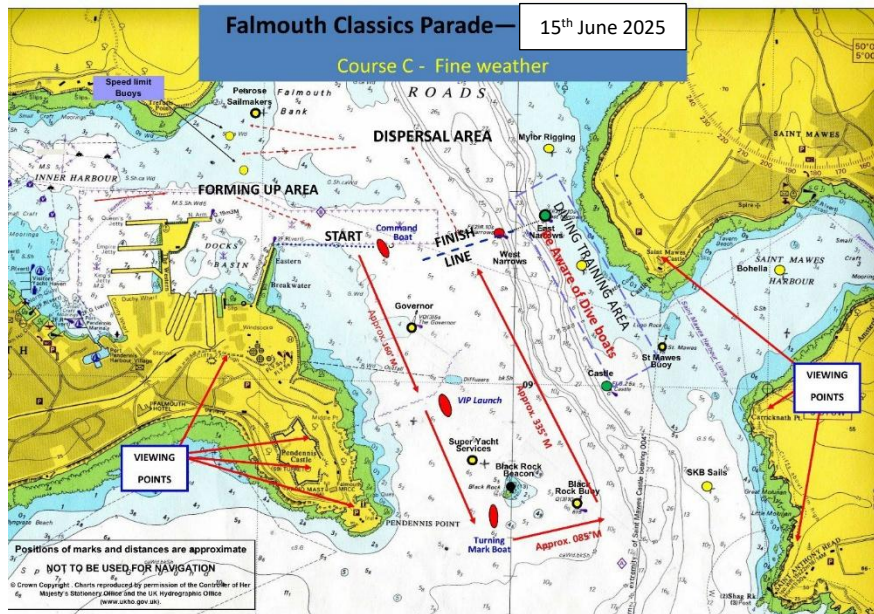

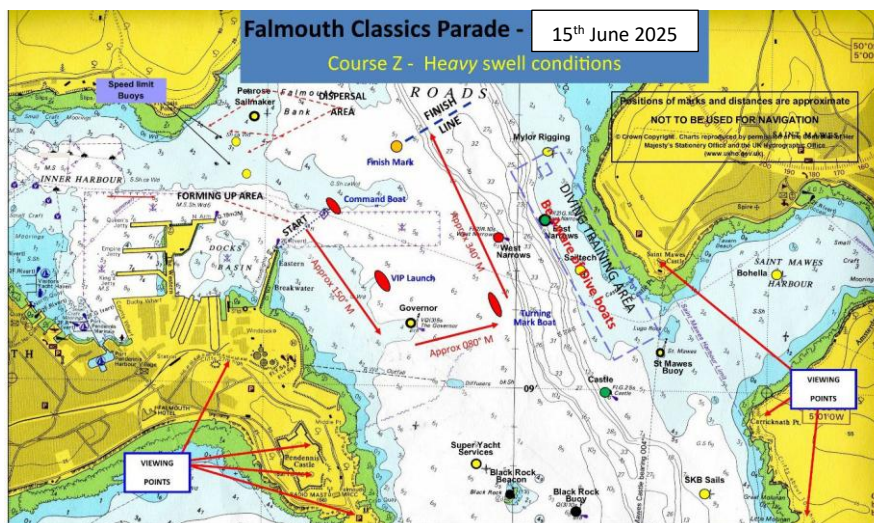
