The first swimmers will enter the water at St Mawes Castle Cove at approximately 1315, and the last swimmers are expected to finish by 1500 at St Just-in-Roseland. There will be up to 10 kayaks/SUP's acting as safety cover plus one or two safety boats. Communications will be via VHF CH 69.

Any users of the water-skiing area are advised to keep a good look-out and keep well clear of swimmers. All mariners are requested to keep well clear of the area during the event and to navigate with caution in the Carrick Roads.
