FALMOUTH SAILING WEEK 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Falmouth Sailing Week Regatta will be held in Falmouth Bay and in Carrick Roads from, Sunday 10th – Saturday 16th August 2025 inclusive.

Approximately 60 yachts will be racing in the Bay and approximately 100 dayboats and dinghies will be racing in the Carrick Roads. There will be multiple races and classes on each day. Port of Falmouth Sailing Association (PoFSA) are coordinating on the water, with the Bay and Carrick race fleets managed separately. The race committee will monitor and communicate with competitors on:

- VHF Ch.72 for the Bay Fleet
- VHF Ch.77 for the Carrick Fleet

A mixture of trapezoid, regatta, and long-distance courses will be set on the day depending on prevailing conditions. Please note that additional temporary race marks will be set during this time, including a number of remote-controlled race marks.

Mariners are requested to navigate with particular caution during this period and are reminded of Falmouth Harbour Bye-Law 13, which requires masters of small craft to avoid obstructing or impeding racing vessels: [Falmouth Harbour \(General\) Bye-Laws](#)

Commercial craft, warships and auxiliaries are requested to call Falmouth Pilots on VHF CH.09 before entering port limits to determine large vessel movements in relation to regatta courses.
