



# Notice to Mariners

## NO. 21 of 2025

### Red Bull Sea Sprint

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Red Bull Sea Sprint event will take place on Saturday 20th September 2025, within Falmouth inner harbour.

- The event will consist of 6 mixed format races beginning from North Quay, taking the competitors out to an anchored vessel off Trefusis Point, and finishing back at North Quay.
- There will be 6 pilot gigs involved in each race.
- The first half of each race will consist of a swim from North Quay to nearby pilot gigs. There will be approximately 50 swimmers, and the pilot gigs will be moored to pontoons that are anchored 100m away. This will be followed by a 1km pilot gig row, followed by a short swim onto the anchored vessel. The second half of each race will have the same format as the first but in reverse.
- The races will start at 11:30 and are anticipated to last a few hours in total.
- There will be 5 safety crafts in attendance, operating on VHF channel 72.
- Nonparticipating vessels are requested to keep well clear of the racing activity and be reminded of Byelaw 13 of the Falmouth Harbour (Amendment) Byelaws 1996 regarding obstruction or interference with organised events.

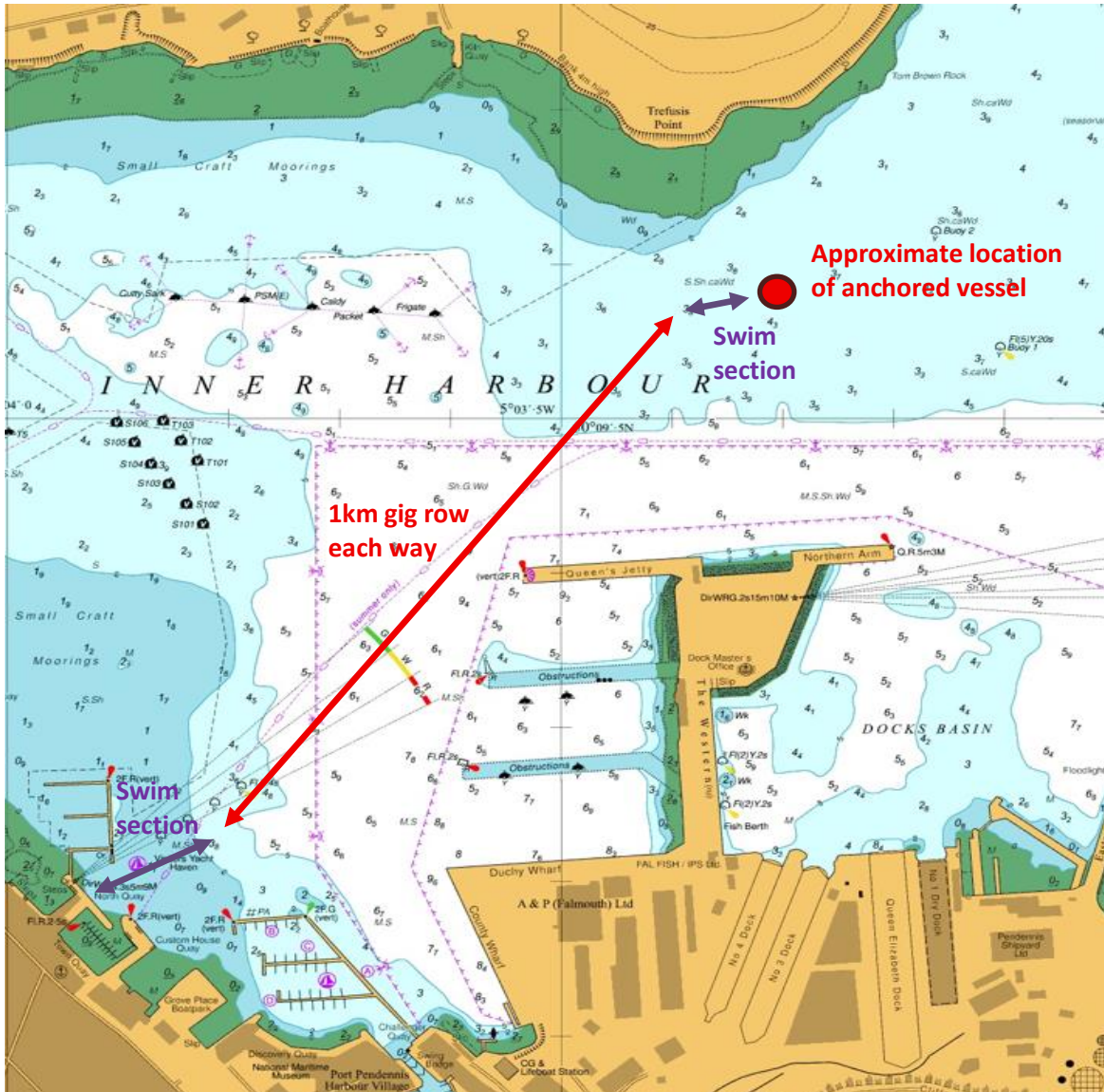
