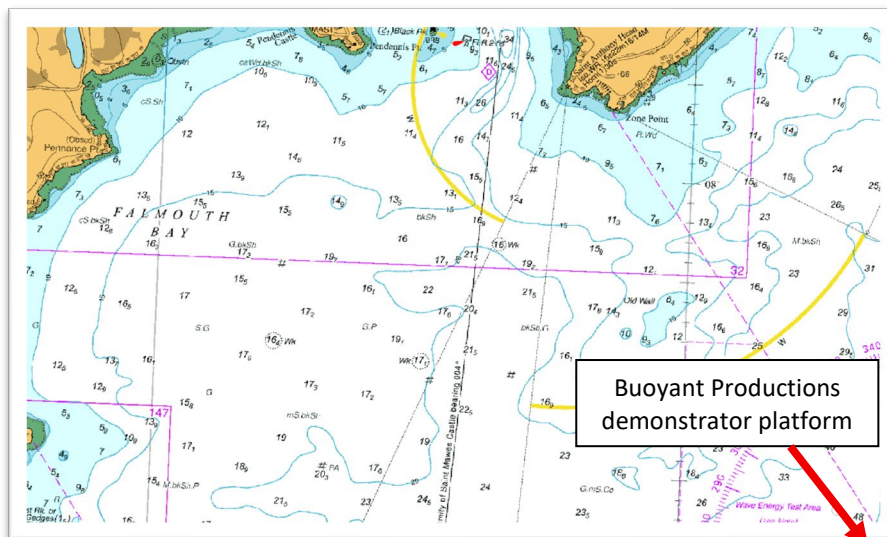
Notice to Mariners No. 25 of 2025

Buoyant Productions - Demobilisation

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Buoyant Productions will be demobilising the platform currently on site at FaBTest from Monday 29th September.

This will involve a special category tow so the vessels involved will have restricted mobility. Vessels Pegasus and Morva will be involved with the tow from FaBTest to Falmouth Docks. Once the tow is complete they will then remove the device moorings.

Mariners are advised to proceed with particular caution in the area of these vessels. This notice is self-cancelling on completion of the demobilisation activities.
