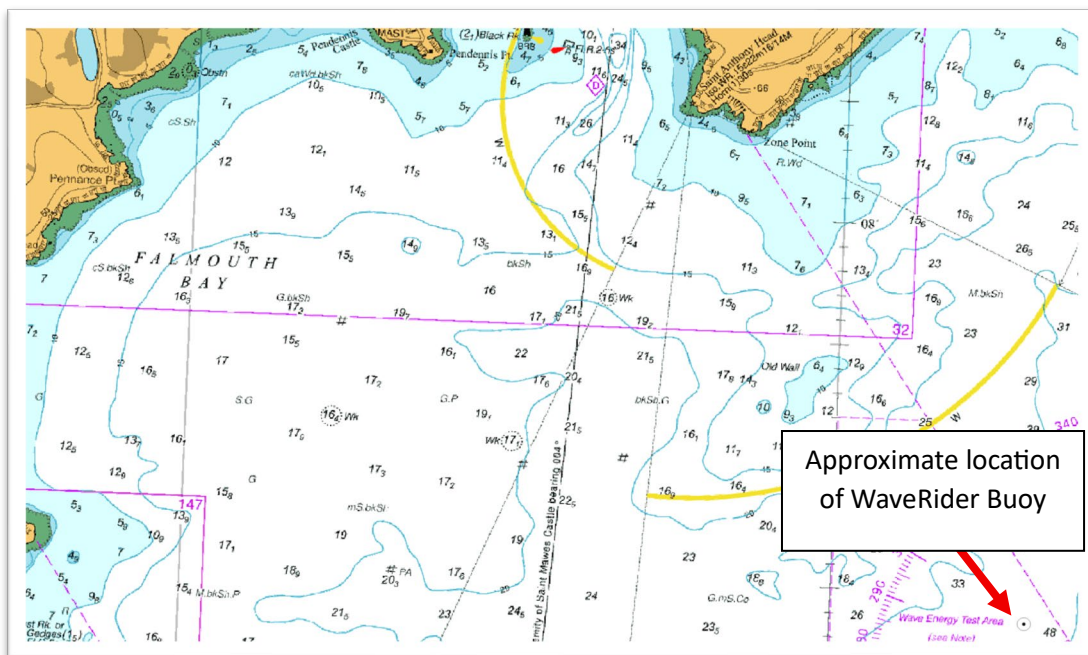

The WaveRider buoy is 70cm diameter and is lit – Fl (5) Y 20s.

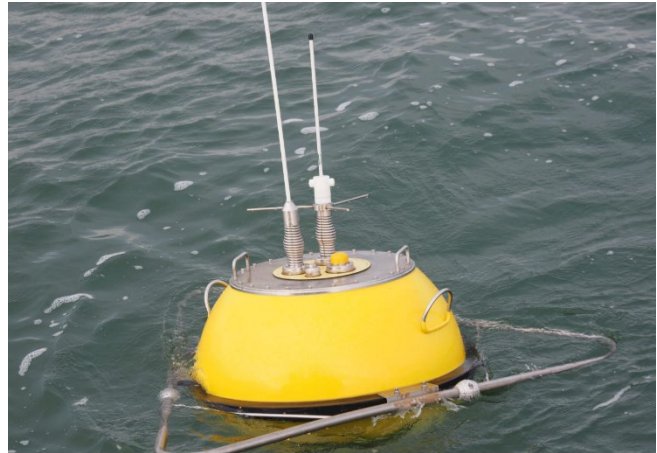


Photo on left of WaveRider buoy out of water and on right installed profile.
