This notice is self-cancelling on completion of the event.

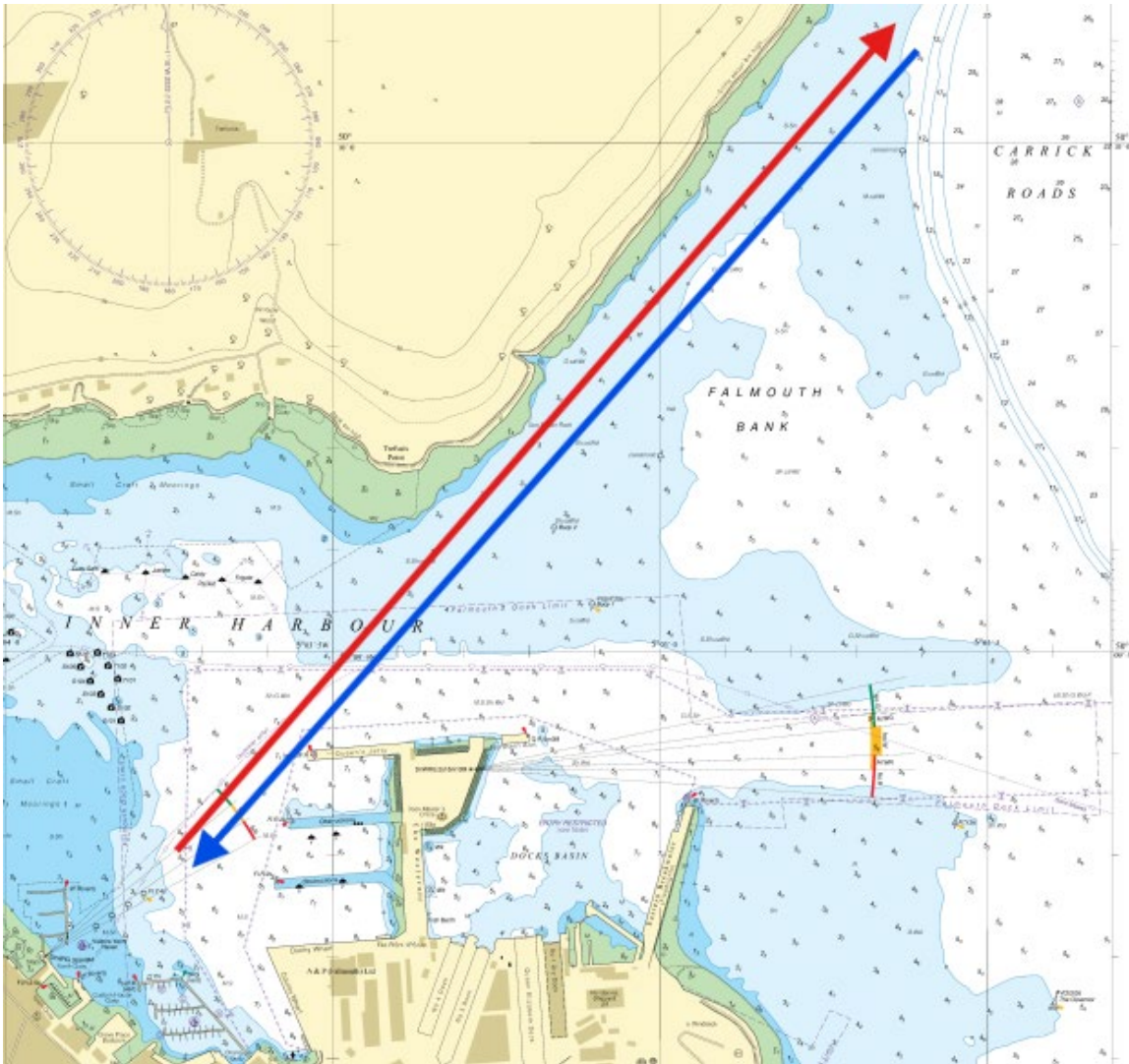
