Surfers Against Sewage – Paddle Out Protest

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that **Surfers Against Sewage** will be running a paddle out protest from Gyllyngvase Beach on Saturday 16th May 2026. The protest is subject to the weather conditions and a safety assessment on the day.

The event will likely take place between 11:00 – 13:00 and will involve up to 500 people using a variety of small paddle craft. The event will be marshaled, and participants are requested to remain close to the shore during the protest - as indicated in the chartlet on the following page.

Vessels navigating in the area are requested to keep well clear of the event, keep a good visual watch and proceed with caution in that area. Vessels are reminded of the [Restricted Vessel Zone off Gyllyngvase Beach](#).

This notice is self-cancelling upon completion of the event.

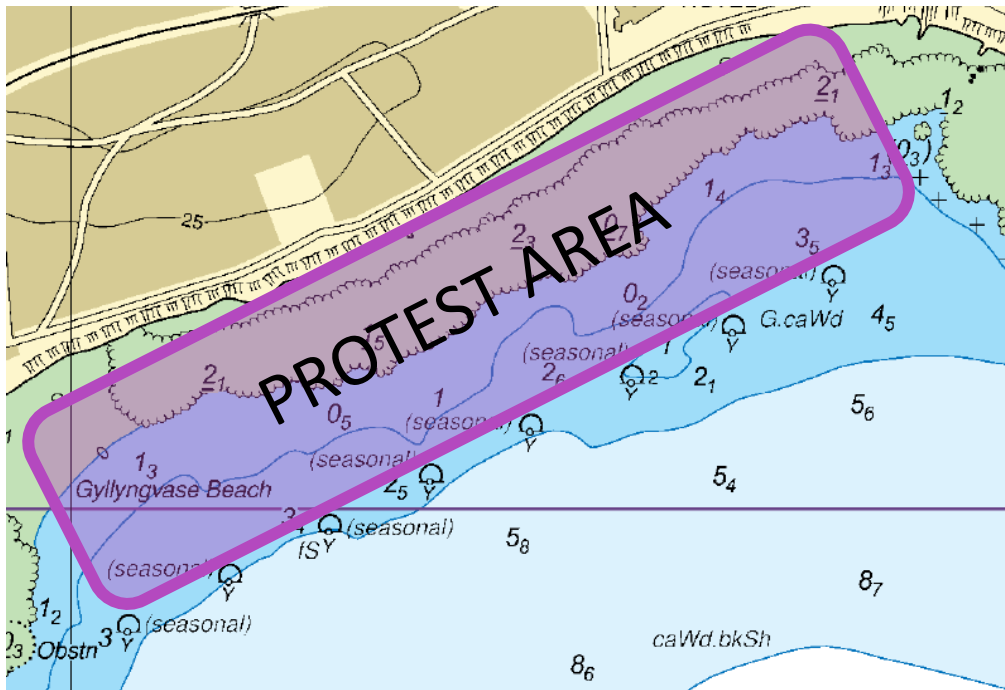


Figure 1© Crown Copyright and/or database rights. Reproduced by permission of The Keeper of Public Records and the UK Hydrographic Office (www.GOV.uk/UKHO) NOT TO BE USED FOR NAVIGATION
