



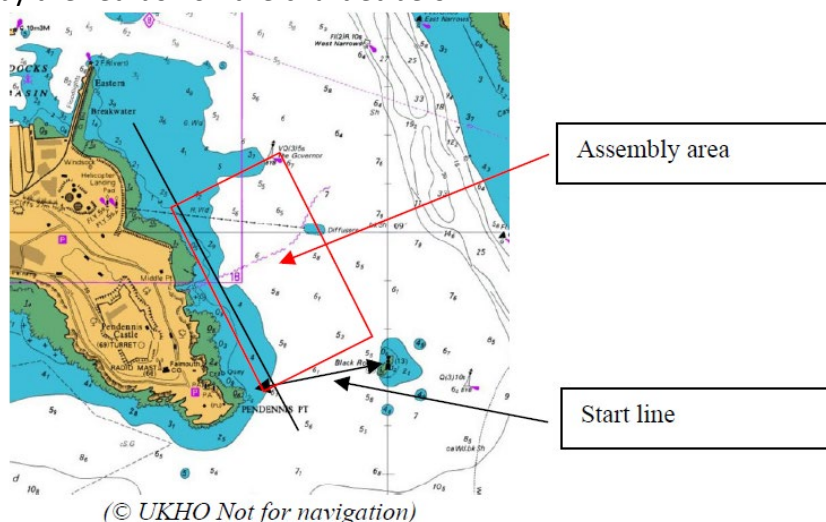
Notice to Mariners NO. 12 of 2026

Yachting Monthly Celtic Triangle Offshore Race

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the start of the Yachting Monthly Celtic Triangle Offshore Race will take place off Pendennis Point on Sunday 31st of May 2026. The first warning signal will be at 10:00.

- The start will be between laid marks between Pendennis Point and Black Rock Beacon.
- There will be 35 boats spread over 3 starts with a mix of single and double-handed entries. All vessels are under 14m LOA.
- RCYC are the organising authority, and communications will be over VHF channel 72.

Vessels not involved in the race are requested to keep clear of the start line and the assembly area marked by the red box on the chartlet below.



Mariners are requested to navigate with caution during this period and are reminded of Falmouth Harbour Byelaw 13 which requires masters of small craft to avoid obstructing or impeding racing vessels.

This notice is self-cancelling after all racing vessels have departed Falmouth Bay.
