# FALMOUTH PILOT GIG CLUB SUMMER REGATTA 2026

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Falmouth Pilot Gig Club Summer Regatta will take place from Gyllyngvase Beach on Saturday 13 June 2026. Racing is scheduled between 1030 - 1730.

The event is expected to involve up to 36 Pilot Gigs and associated safety craft operating within Falmouth Bay and launching from Gyllyngvase Beach. The race area will be located seaward of the restricted vessel area and 4-knot buoys, between Gyllyngvase Beach and Castle Beach.

A number of support vessels and race officials' craft will be present throughout the event.

**Mariners are requested to:**

- Navigate with caution in the vicinity
- Maintain a good lookout for the racing gigs, safety craft and support vessels.
- Proceed at a safe speed and minimise wash when transiting near the race area.
- Give the racing fleet a wide berth wherever practicable.

**Harbour Byelaw 13.** Small vessels shall not obstruct, impede or interfere with the regatta and shall comply with any directions issued by the Harbour Master or Deputies.

The organisers have advised that racing may be temporarily suspended to allow the safe passage of vessels associated with the Falmouth Classics Regatta or other significant harbour traffic.

The event may be cancelled should adverse weather conditions arise.

This notice is self-cancelling on completion of the event.
