Notice to Mariners No. 15 of 2026

Active Seagrass restoration - Swanpool

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that seagrass restoration activities will be undertaken within the Swanpool area during the period 14 June 2026 to 12 July 2026 (weather dependent).

The works form part of an active seagrass restoration project and may involve the temporary placement of equipment and materials on the seabed. The activity is being undertaken under a licence issued by the Marine Management Organisation (MMO).

The presence of equipment and materials associated with the project may present a hazard to navigation. All vessels should remain clear of the designated restoration area.

Harbour users are requested to:

- Keep clear of the areas highlighted on the chartlet overleaf.
- Navigate with caution when operating in the vicinity of the works.
- Avoid anchoring within the restoration area.

Mariners are reminded that the area enclosed by the Yellow 4-knot Special Marks is a Voluntary No Anchoring Zone. Anchoring within this area may damage sensitive seagrass habitats and hinder ongoing restoration efforts.

This Notice shall remain in force until completion of the works and is self-cancelling.

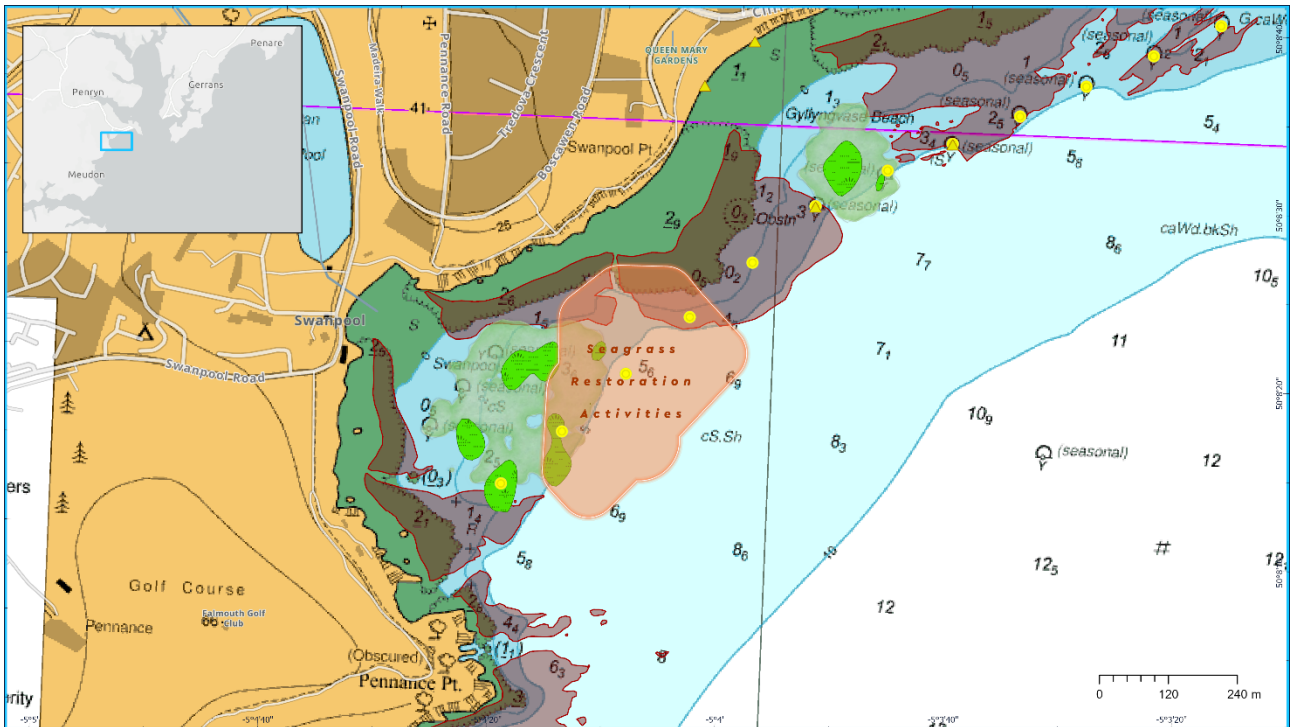

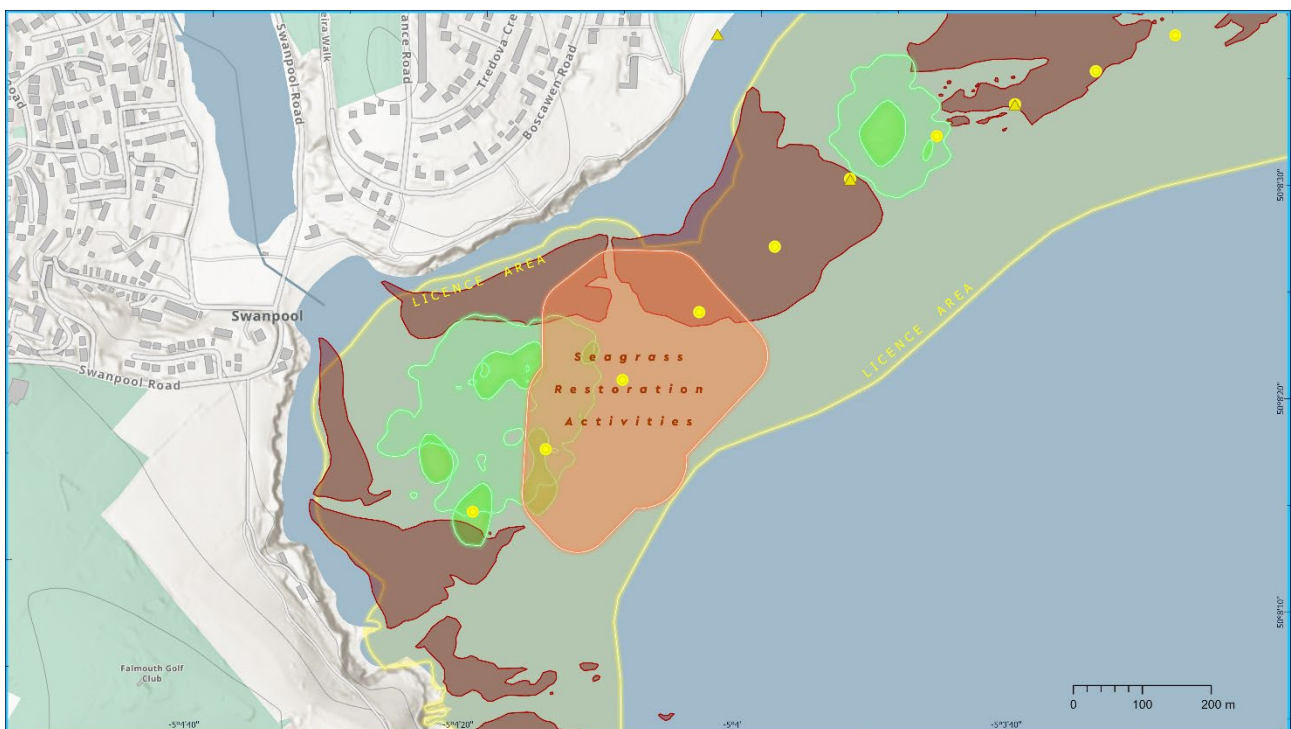
