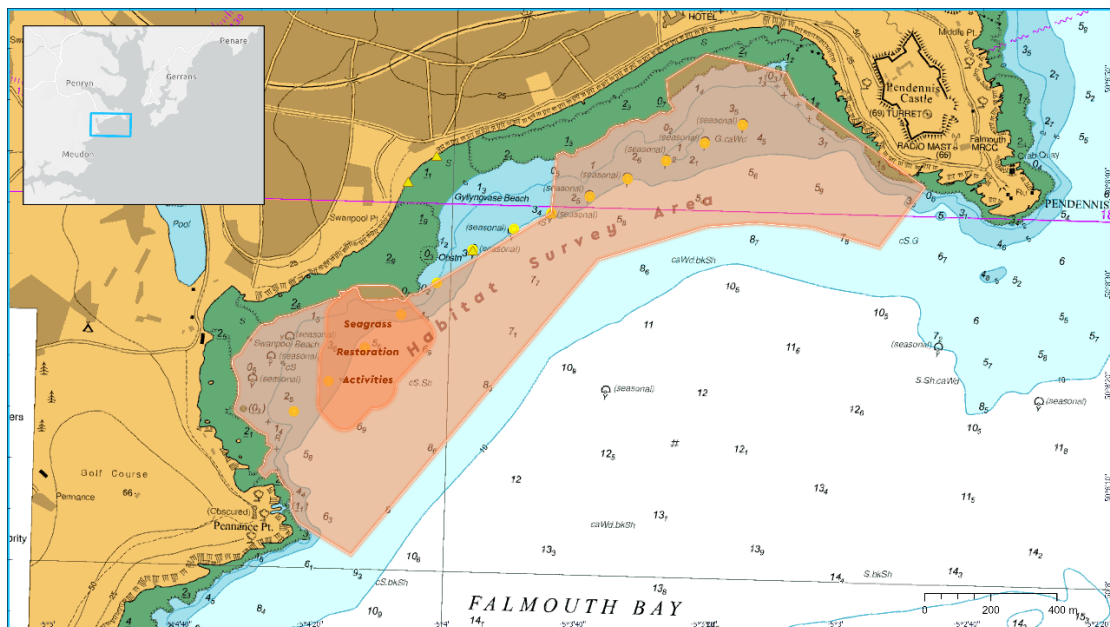
# Notice to Mariners

### Seagrass restoration surveys

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that during week commencing 21<sup>st</sup> September 2026, acoustic, drop down camera and dive surveys will be undertaken in the water off Swanpool, Gyllyngvase and Castle beaches. All water users, including vessels, kayaks, swimmers and boarders are requested to keep a wide berth of the of the vessels 'Atlantic Divers' and 'Reef Runner' whilst operations are taking place.

The acoustic and drop down camera surveys will take place in the orange area Diving activities are planned within the Seagrass Restoration area, both shown in the chart below.
