Unexploded Ordnance Update 01

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that today (23rd September 2026) the unexploded ordnance located east of Falmouth Docks will be moved to a new position at 50° 08'N 005° 03'W. See chartlet 1.

During the movement of the device, a rolling 755m exclusion zone will exist. See chartlet 2 for reference, 755m is indicated by the red circles. Vessels should stay well clear and outside of any guard vessels. These will consist of Pilot Boats, Patrol Boats, Tugs and a Fire Boat.

An exclusion zone of 500m from the above position, indicated by the red circle on chartlet 1, will be in force. All water users must keep well clear of the exclusion zone. The centre of the exclusion zone will be marked by a large unlit yellow special mark, see the photo below.



Port users should keep a listening watch on VHF 16 for further updates from the Coastguard.

This notice will remain in force until the ordnance has been dealt with, and the yellow special mark has been removed.

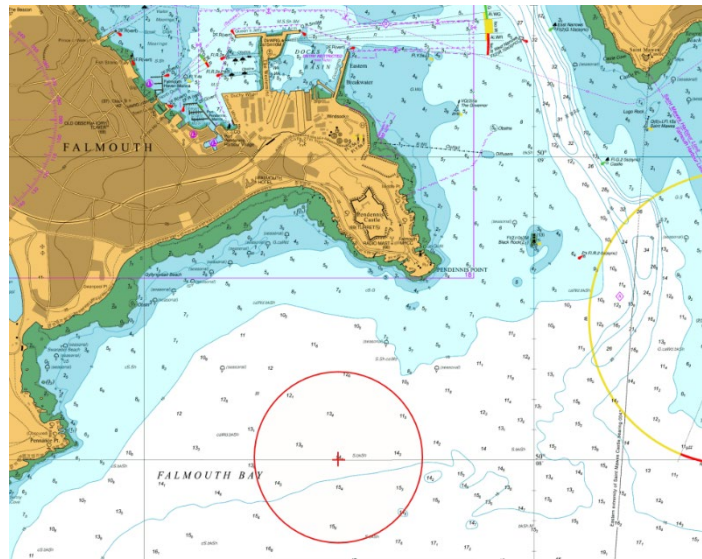

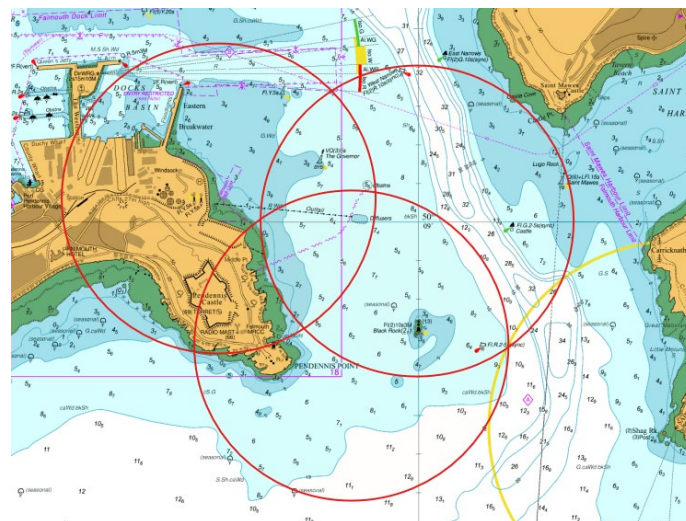
